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### **DATE OF DESCRIPTION** 2002

**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 0.8 km (0.5 mi) south along the Canyon-Tower highway from the ranger station in Tower Junction. Bench mark is in an 8- by 12-foot granite boulder that projects 46-inches above the ground surface (the largest boulder southwest from a pullout under a cluster of trees), 27.1 m (88.9 ft) northwest of the northwest end of a highway pullout that has track road extending from it to stables (for Roosevelt Lodge), 23.9 m (78.5 ft) south-southwest of the centerline of the highway, and 2.4 m above the highway.
