**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 3.1 km (1.95 mi) west along the Mammoth-Tower highway from the ranger station in Tower Junction. Bench mark is 52.9 m (173.6 ft) northeast of the southeast end of a road cut, 5.8 m (19.0 ft) northwest of the center of the highway, and about level with the highway. Access to datum point is had through a 5-inch logo cap.

In 2008 the bench mark was searched for and not found, presumed destroyed by roadwork. The location “5.8 m (19.0 ft) northwest of the center of the highway” in the NGS description is near the edge of the widened pavement.



View northeast along highway at probable location of bench mark. Description puts the mark within the road cut to the left, too close to centerline to have survived the road work.
