**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 10.9 km (6.75 mi) south along the Canyon-Lake highway from the junction at Canyon Village, thence 15.0 km (9.30 mi) west on foot along Trout Creek Trail (the old fire road to Mary Lake), thence 1.8 km (1.1 mi) southwest along the Mary Mountain Trail. Bench mark is cemented in a drill hole in the top of a 1.5-foot exposed area of an embedded boulder which projects 4 inches, at the highest point of a ridge and in a small field of embedded boulders, 12.2 m (40.0 ft) southeast of the trail center, 6.7 m (22.0 ft) northwest of a 16-inch leaning pine tree, and 0.5 m above the trail.

In 2008 the bench mark was searched for and not found. The bench mark might be buried under dirt or pine needles.
