**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 10.1 km (6.30 mi) south along the Madison-West Thumb highway from Madison Junction, thence 3.5 km (2.15 mi) east along a service road and Mary Mountain Trail to a foot bridge across Nez Perce Creek, thence 11.0 km (6.85 mi) east along Mary Mountain Trail. Bench mark is cemented in a drill hole in the north edge of a 4- by 5-foot exposed area of an embedded boulder which projects 2 feet, 21.3 m (69.9 ft) north-northwest of the trail center, 20.4 m (66.9 ft) north of a 20-inch pine tree and red trail marker sign, 4.0 m (13.1 ft) northwest of an 18-inch pine tree that is leaning to the north, and 2.4 m above the trail.

In 2008 the bench mark was searched for and not found. There are three boulders in an area that resembles NGS description, but no bench mark was found.
