DESCRIPTION Proceed About 5.85 miles south along the Mammoth Hot Springs-Norris Junction highway from the post office at Mammoth Hot Springs. Station is on the east side of the highway, directly across from Swan Lake and a paved highway pullout with a sign describing the Gallatin Range. The bench mark is 54 feet east of the center line of the highway, 207 feet north of a concrete manhole in water line, 106 feet southeast of and across the highway from a small lone spruce tree (the only tree in the area), adjacent to a rusted witness post, and on the top of a 5/8-inch copper coated steel rod that is driven to a depth of 16 feet and encased in a 6-inch tile projecting 5 inches.
