DESCRIPTION Proceed 1.15 mi west along the Madison-West Thumb highway from the junction at West Thumb, thence 6.2 km (3.85 mi) westerly along an abandoned service road, which has been reclaimed but was still recognizable in 2009, to an abandoned gravel pit, thence about 1.3 mi westerly along dry creek. Bench mark is in the southwest face of a 5- by 6-ft boulder that projects 24-inches, 100 paces north-northwest of a point where the creek bed makes a sharp bend to the north, 3.0 m (9.8 ft) north-northeast of the center of the creek bed, 0.6 m (2.0 ft) south-southwest of a small cairn, and 1.0 m above the creek bed.
