**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 14.8 km (9.20 mi) east along the Mammoth-Tower highway from the park headquarters in Mammoth Hot Springs. Bench mark is in the west end of a lava outcrop in a highway cut (the first lava outcrop going uphill from the west), approximately 100 m east of the west end of a highway cut and near the west end of a rocky outcrop in the cut, 5.9 m (19.4 ft) north of the centerline of the highway, and 1.0 m above the highway. The bench mark may be covered by dirt.
