**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 11.1 km (6.90 mi) north along the Canyon-Tower highway from the junction at Canyon Village. Bench mark is near the center of the most southern half of a 5- by 7-foot exposed area of bedrock in a roadcut on the east side of the highway, 53.1 m (174.2 ft) east of the north end of a pullout, 38.4 m (126.0 ft) southwest of the northeast end of the cut, 7.2 m (23.6 ft) southeast of the centerline of the highway, 0.5 m (1.6 ft) northeast of the southwest end of the cut, and 0.9 m above the highway.

In 2002 this bench mark was in danger of being destroyed by roadwork. If it falls in the area that will be disturbed it will be reset probably to a point farther north next to a creek, also on the east side of the highway, set into bedrock up the drainage.
