**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 10.1 km (6.30 mi) south along the Madison-West Thumb highway from Madison Junction, thence 3.5 km (2.15 mi) east along a service road and Mary Mountain Trail to a foot bridge across Nez Perce Creek, thence 6.3 km (3.90 mi) east along Mary Mountain Trail. Bench mark is cemented in a drill hole near the center of a 1.5- by 3-foot dome-shaped boulder that projects 14 inches along the south slope of a wooded ridge, 58.0 m (190.3 ft) north of the trail, 54.0 m (177.2 ft) east of a dry wash, 6.0 m (19.7 ft) north of the foot of the ridge, and 4.0 m above the trail.

In 2008 the bench mark was searched for and not found. The bench mark probably exists, but the boulder referenced in the NGS description could not be identified.
