DESCRIPTION Proceed 11.6 km (7.40 mi) west along Mammoth-Tower highway from the ranger station in Tower Junction. Bench mark is on the south side of the creek that is south of the highway, near the center of a 10- by 40-foot vein of outcropping bedrock at the foot of the north slope of a small knoll, at a small paved highway pullout on the south side of the highway, 44.8 m (147.0 ft) south of the centerline of the highway, 14.3 m (46.9 ft) southwest of a small stream, and 4.0 m below the highway.
