**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 5.6 km (3.50 mi) north along the Canyon-Tower highway from the junction at Canyon Village. Bench mark is near the center of a 2- by 3-foot area of outcropping bedrock, 15.2 m (49.9 ft) west-southwest of the northeast end of a highway pullout (with a “Heart of the caldera” interpretive sign), 6.3 m (20.7 ft) northwest of the centerline of the highway, 0.4 m (1.3 ft) northeast of the southwest end of the outcrop, and 0.3 m above the highway.

In 2002 this bench mark was in danger of being destroyed by roadwork. If it falls in the area that will be disturbed it will probably be reset into a small boulder on the east side of road.
