**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 10.1 km (6.30 mi) south along the Madison-West Thumb highway from Madison Junction, thence 3.5 km (2.15 mi) east along a service road and Mary Mountain Trail to a foot bridge across Nez Perce Creek, thence 3.2 km (2.00 mi) east along Mary Mountain Trail. Bench mark is cemented in a drill hole in the top of a 1.5- by 2.5-foot exposed area of a rock outcrop along the south slope of a wooded ridge that projects 1 foot, 30.0 m (98.4 ft) north of the trail, 12.0 m (39.4 ft) north of the base of the ridge, and 9.0 m above the trail.
