**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 5.60 mi west along the Mammoth-Tower highway from the ranger station in Tower Junction. Bench mark is in a 3- by 4-foot lava outcrop protruding from the northeast end of a large highway cut, 13.1 m (43.0 ft) west of the west end of a stone guard rail, 6.4 m (21.0 ft) north of the centerline of the highway, and 4.0 m above the highway.
