**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 10.1 km (6.30 mi) south along the Madison-West Thumb highway from Madison Junction, thence 3.5 km (2.15 mi) east along a service road and Mary Mountain Trail to a foot bridge across Nez Perce Creek, thence 1.6 km (1.00 mi) east along Mary Mountain Trail. Bench mark is cemented in a drill hole near the east edge of a 3- by 3-foot boulder at the bottom of a dry wash, 40.1 m (131.6 ft) north of the north bank of Nez Perce Creek at the foot of a slope, 17.5 m (57.4 ft) north-northeast of a pine tree with an orange trail marker sign, and 3.9 m (12.8 ft) northwest of the trail.
