



### 1915 flow on Lassen Peak

Telephoto view northeast from summit of Brokeoff Mountain (Lassen Peak quadrangle). The west lobe of the dacite flow of May 19–20, 1915 (unit d9) is on the west side of Lassen Peak (unit dl,  $27 \pm 1$  ka). Eagle Peak (unit re,  $66 \pm 4$  ka) is part of the Eagle Peak sequence. Ski Heil Peak (unit ds,  $244 \pm 10$  ka, part of the Bumpass sequence) is mantled by tephra (unit pe) erupted from Eagle Peak. Ridge below and to the left of Ski Heil Peak is composed of the hydrothermally altered andesite of Mount Diller (unit amd,  $387 \pm 10$  ka). Gray slopes in the foreground are the andesites of Mill Canyon (unit amc, 590–470 ka).
