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

The flood boundaries shown were estimated by steady-state hydraulic modeling, as c conditions anticipated at the USGS streamgage. The hydraulic model reflects the land-cover characteristics and any bridge, dam, levee, or other hydraulic structures existing as of December 2011. Unique mete may cause actual streamflows along the modeled reach to vary from those assumed during a flood, which may lead to deviations such as changes in the streambed elevation model used to simulate the land surface. Additional uncertainties and limitations pertinent to this study are described in the document accompanying this set of flood inundation map sheets. If this series of flood-inundation maps will be used in conjunction with National Weater Service (NWS) river forecast, the user should be aware of additional uncertainties that may be inherent or factored into NWS forecast procedures.
