- To enable 3-D content in 3-D PDF, click Options and select appropriate choice.
- Click in black area to activate 3-D features.
- The 3-D toolbar (shown below) will appear above the image after it is activated.



- 1 3-D interaction selection (rotate, pan, and zoom)**—Move the mouse while clicking and holding the left mouse button to interact with the 3-D element
- 2 Select preset views**
- 3 Open model tree**—Select layers to be hidden, isolated, or made transparent
- 4 Toggle between perspective and orthographic projections**
- 5 Enhance lighting**
- 6 Change background color**
- 7 Show and hide cross sections**
