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Iron (Fe) in soil collected from a depth of 0 to 5 centimeters

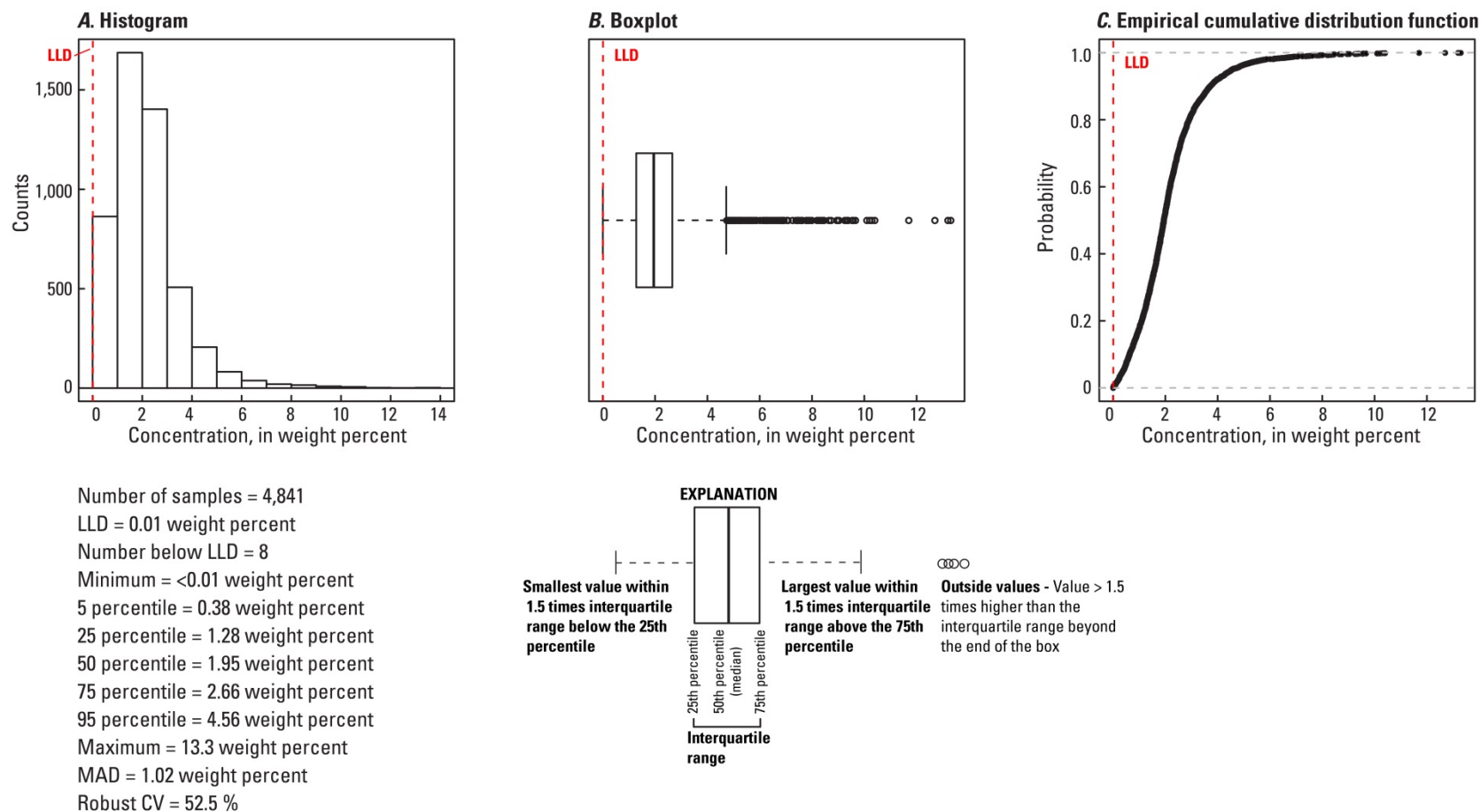


Figure 53. A, Histogram and summary statistics; B, Boxplot; C, Empirical cumulative distribution function; and D, Distribution of iron (Fe) in surface soils collected from a depth of 0 to 5 centimeters, conterminous United States (LLD, lower limit of determination; MAD, median absolute deviation; CV, coefficient of variation; wt. %, weight percent; cm, centimeters).

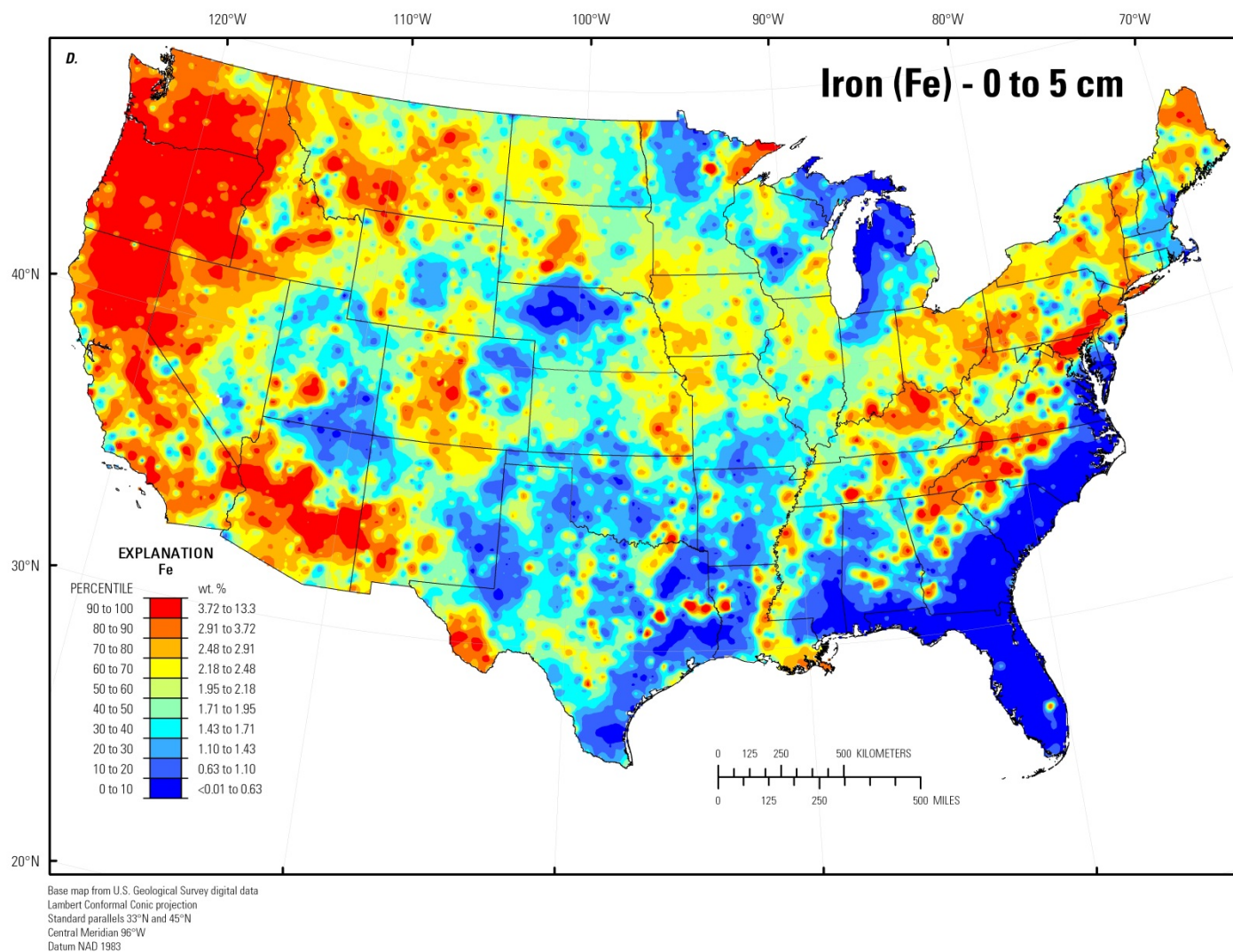


Figure 53. A, Histogram and summary statistics; B, Boxplot; C, Empirical cumulative distribution function; and D, Distribution of iron (Fe) in surface soils collected from a depth of 0 to 5 centimeters, conterminous United States (LLD, lower limit of determination; MAD, median absolute deviation; CV, coefficient of variation; wt. %, weight percent; cm, centimeters).—Continued

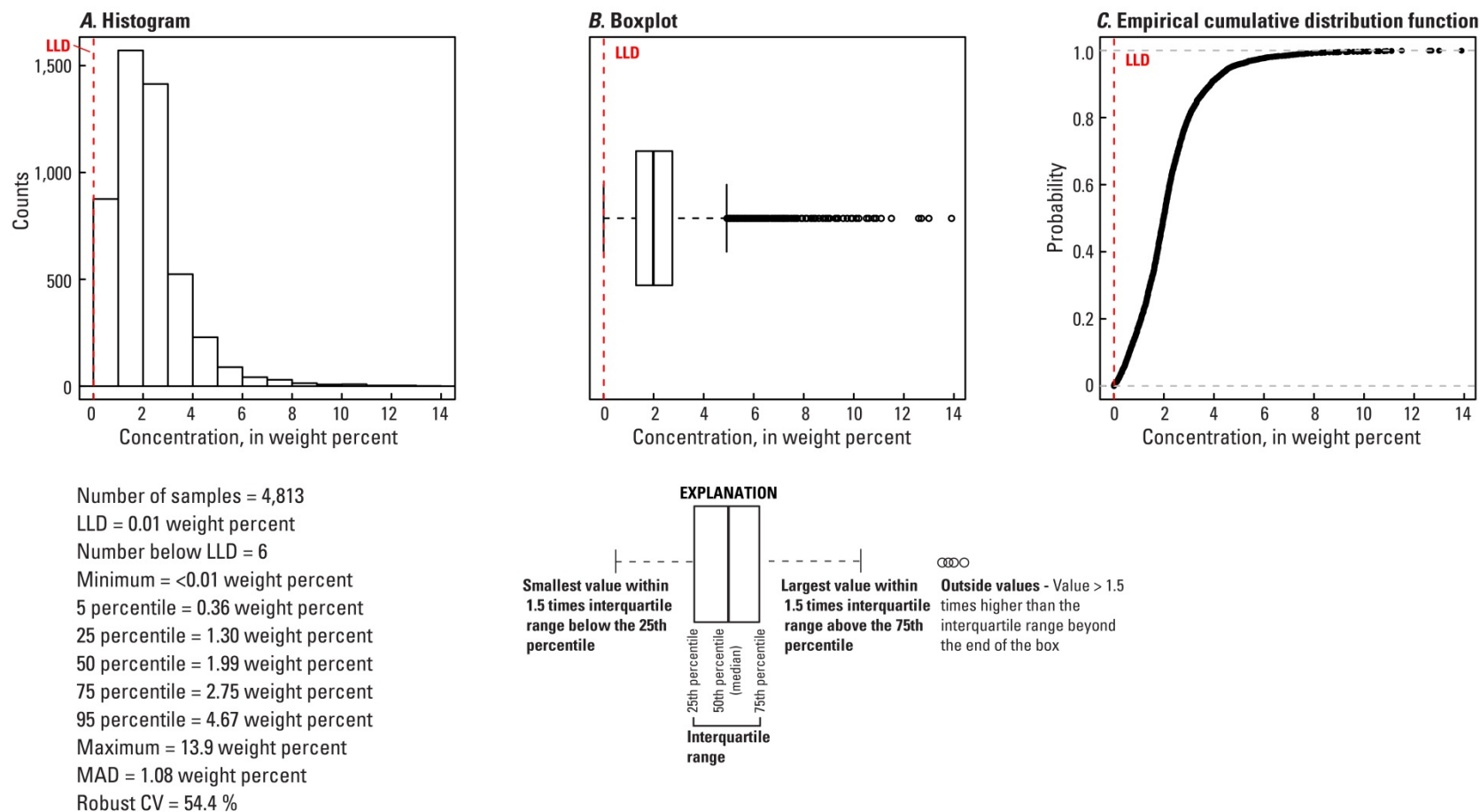


Figure 54. A, Histogram and summary statistics; B, Boxplot; C, Empirical cumulative distribution function; and D, Distribution of iron (Fe) in the soil A horizon, conterminous United States (LLD, lower limit of determination; MAD, median absolute deviation; CV, coefficient of variation; wt. %, weight percent).

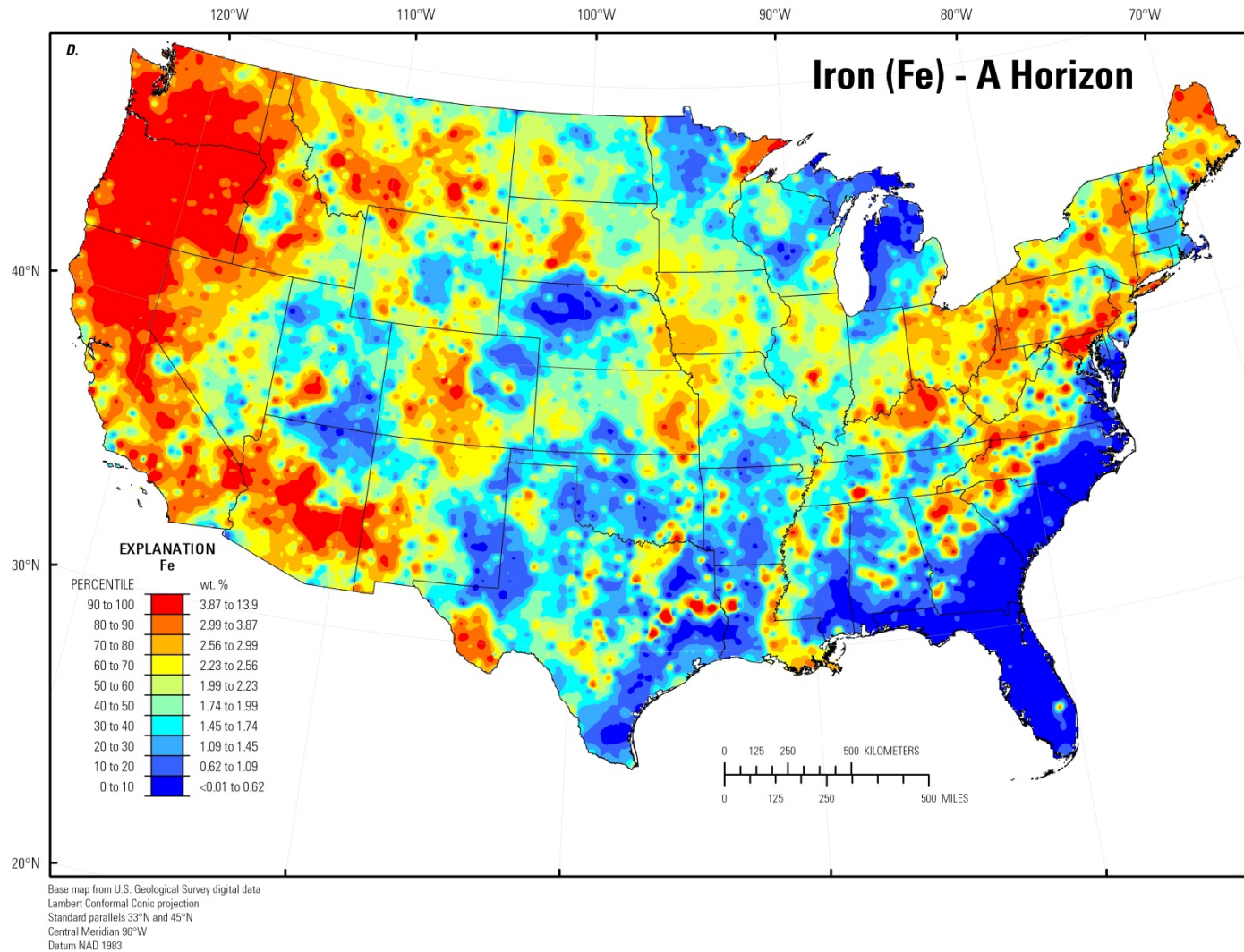


Figure 54. A, Histogram and summary statistics; B, Boxplot; C, Empirical cumulative distribution function; and D, Distribution of iron (Fe) in the soil A horizon, conterminous United States (LLD, lower limit of determination; MAD, median absolute deviation; CV, coefficient of variation; wt. %, weight percent).—Continued

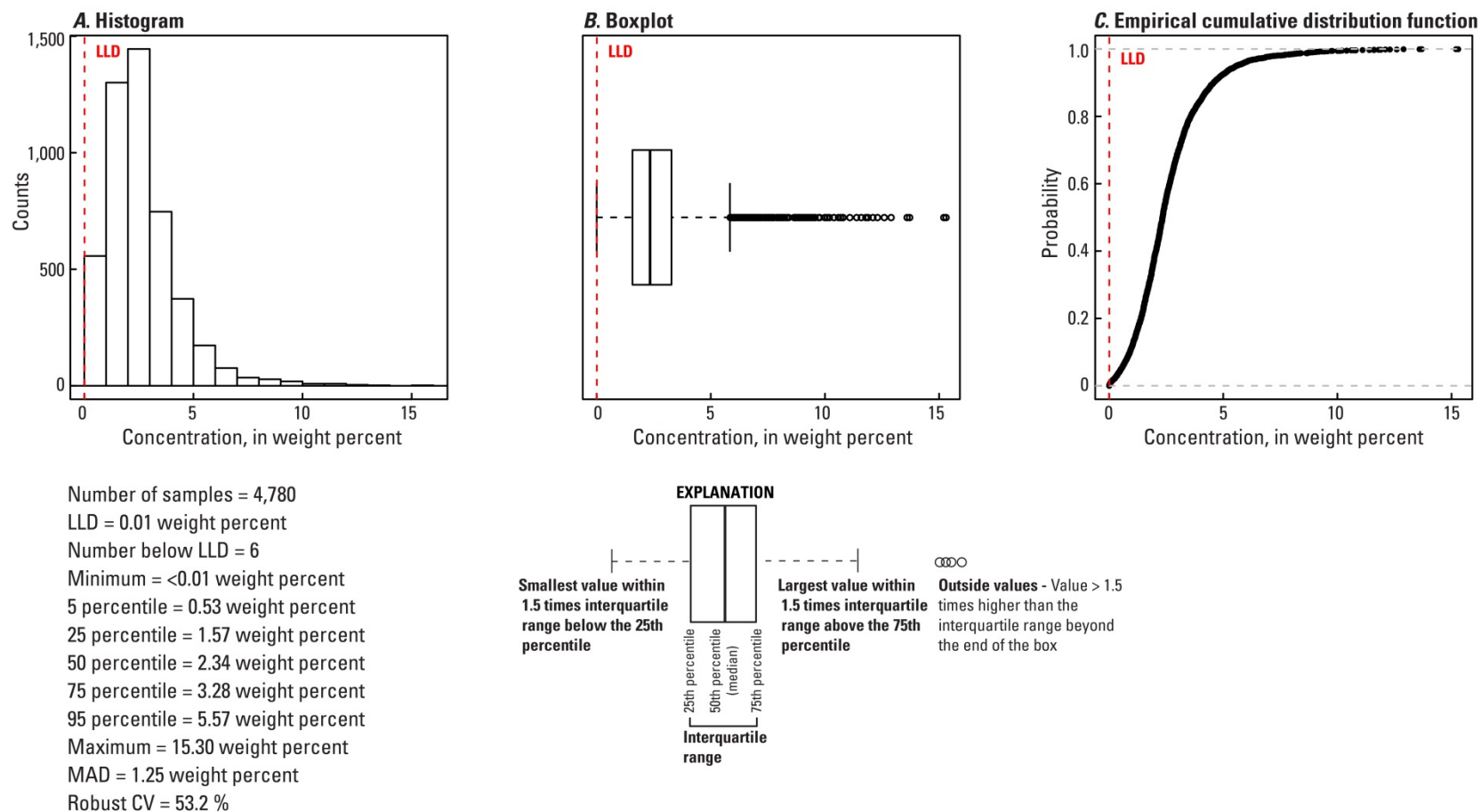


Figure 55. A, Histogram and summary statistics; B, Boxplot; C, Empirical cumulative distribution function; and D, Distribution of iron (Fe) in the soil C horizon, conterminous United States (LLD, lower limit of determination; MAD, median absolute deviation; CV, coefficient of variation; wt. %, weight percent).

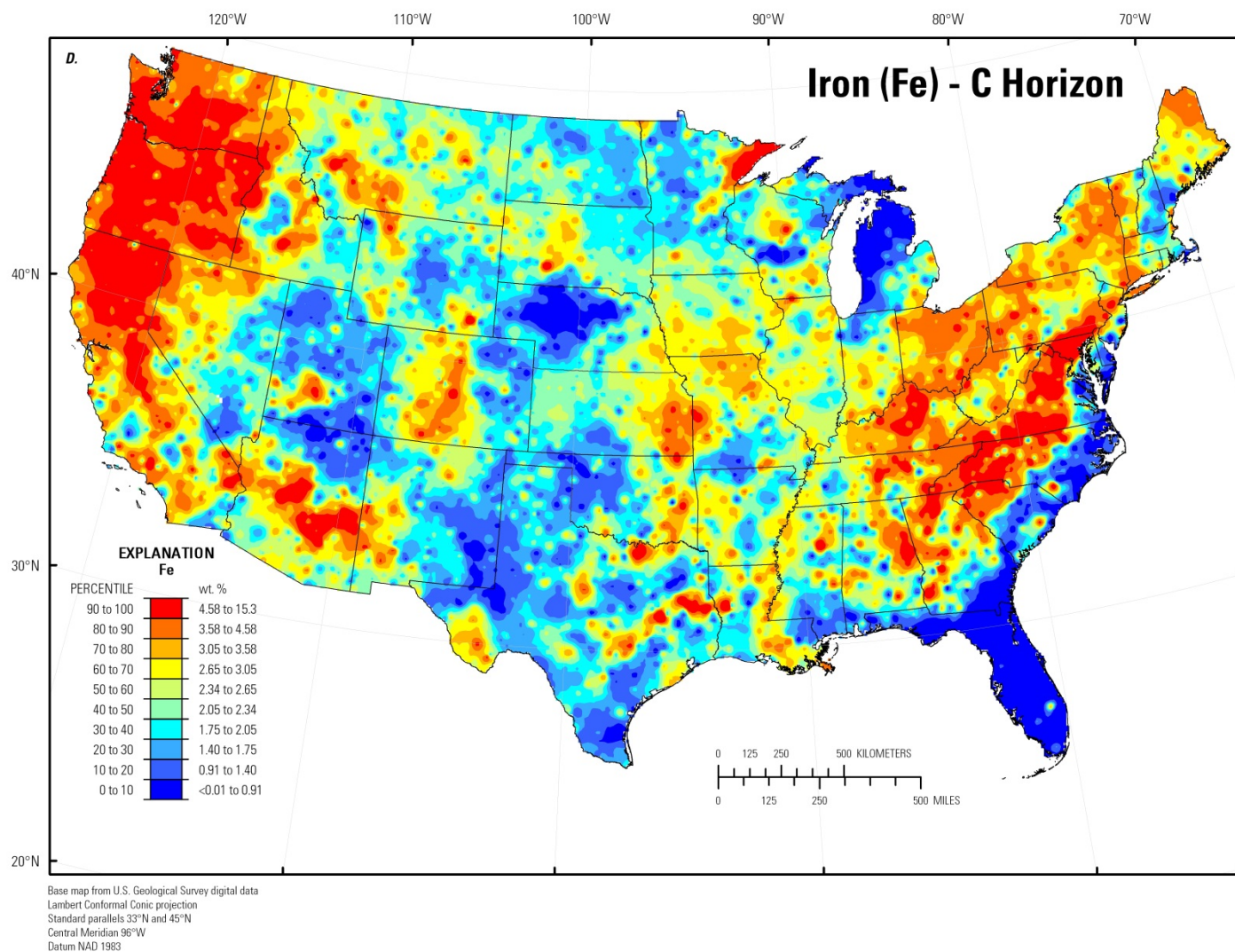


Figure 55. A, Histogram and summary statistics; B, Boxplot; C, Empirical cumulative distribution function; and D, Distribution of iron (Fe) in the soil C horizon, conterminous United States (LLD, lower limit of determination; MAD, median absolute deviation; CV, coefficient of variation; wt. %, weight percent).—Continued
