

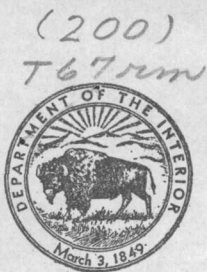

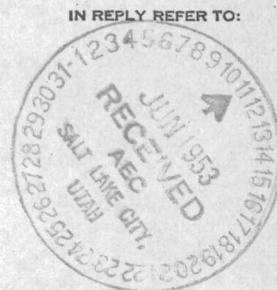

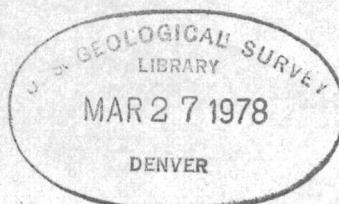
Dear Phil:
