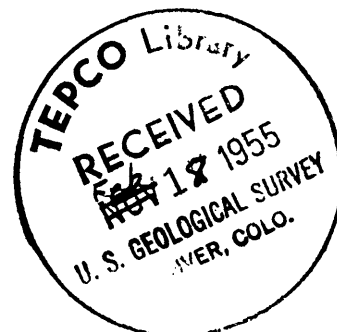
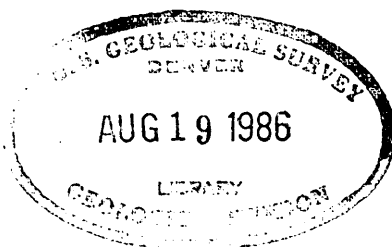
Dear Bob:

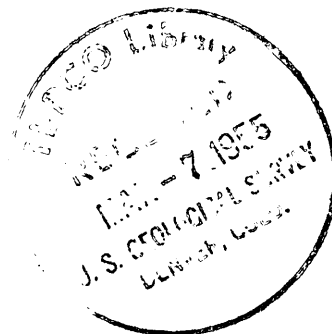
