Streamflow equaled or exceeded 90 percent of the time, in million gallons per day, approximately equal to the lowest 30-day average flow having a two-year recurrence interval.

USABLE STORAGE
Usable storage in ponds, lakes, and reservoirs, in million gallons.

FAVORABLE GROUND-WATER AREAS
Areas designated by symbols are especially favorable for the sustained development of large ground-water supplies from stratified drift. Estimated long-term yields for these areas are given in table 31. Number within area is the average daily yield for a year, in million gallons per day, exceeded 7 years out of 10 under stated conditions of development.
