
-  BASIN DRAINAGE DIVIDE
-  PUBLIC WATER-SUPPLY RESERVOIR
(NAME SHOWN)
-  PUBLIC WATER-SUPPLY WELL OR WELL FIELD
-  AREAS SERVED BY PUBLIC WATER-SUPPLY MAINS
Includes those of municipal water departments, private water companies, institutions and some of the larger community water systems.
-  SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITY
-  AREAS SERVED BY SEWER SYSTEMS
Sewer systems may lead to sewage treatment facilities or empty directly into nearby streams
- SITES OF WATER WITHDRAWAL
 -  FROM A STREAM
 -  FROM AN AQUIFER
- SITES OF WATER RETURN
 -  TO THE GROUND
 -  TO A STREAM

Numbers indicate the amount of water withdrawn or returned annually at each site during the period 1961-67 in millions of gallons per year. Connecting lines are diagrammatic and intended only to connect a source of water to a point of its disposal. Only the major public and industrial water users are represented.
