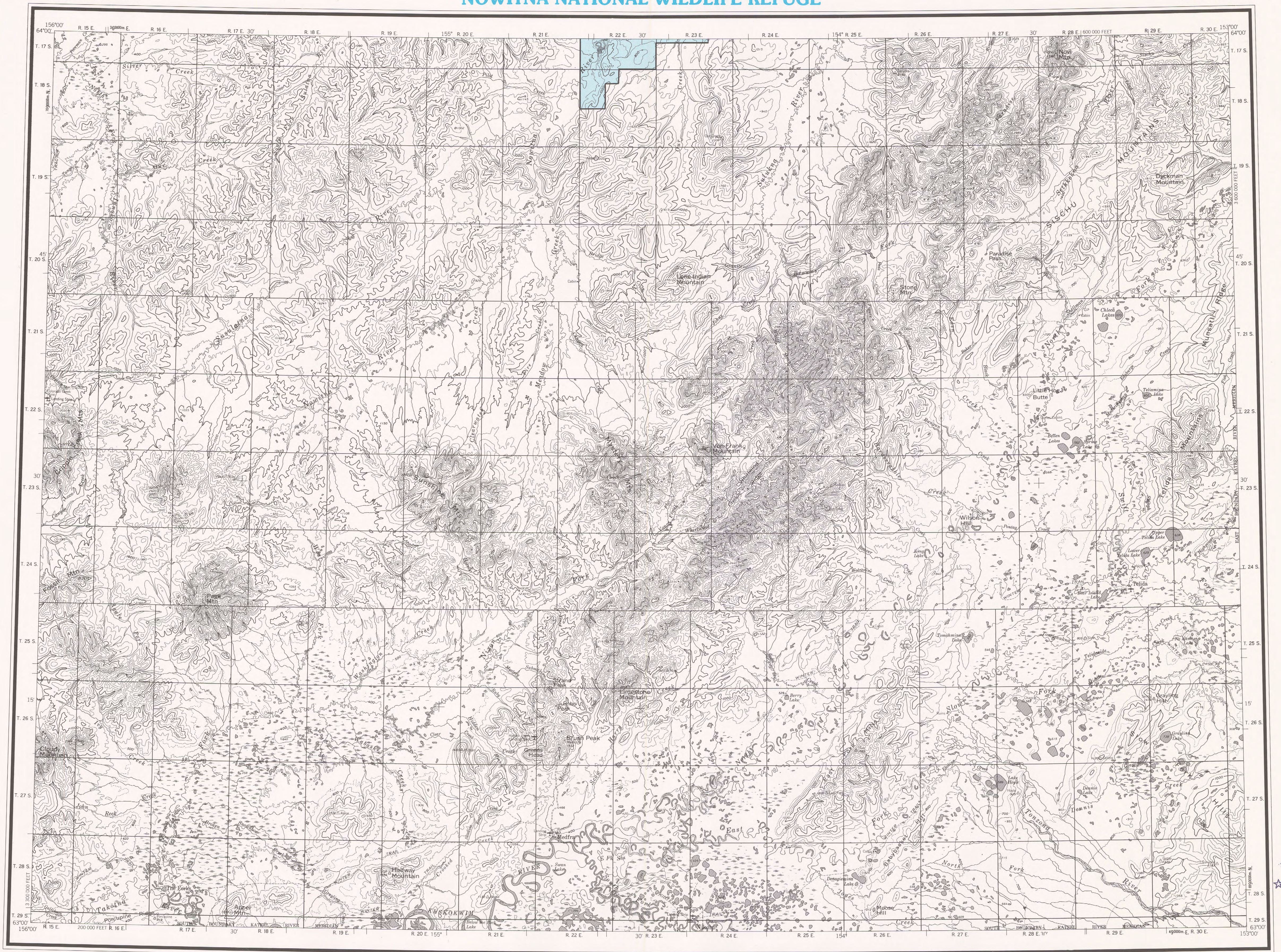


NOWITNA NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE

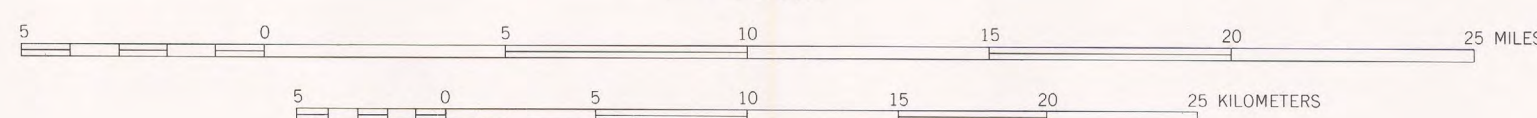

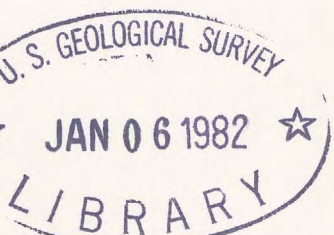
