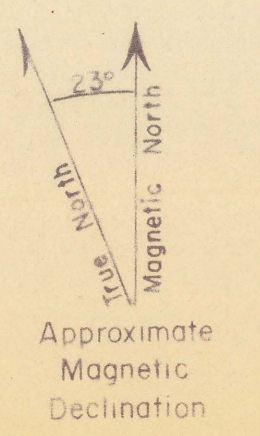




EXPLANATION

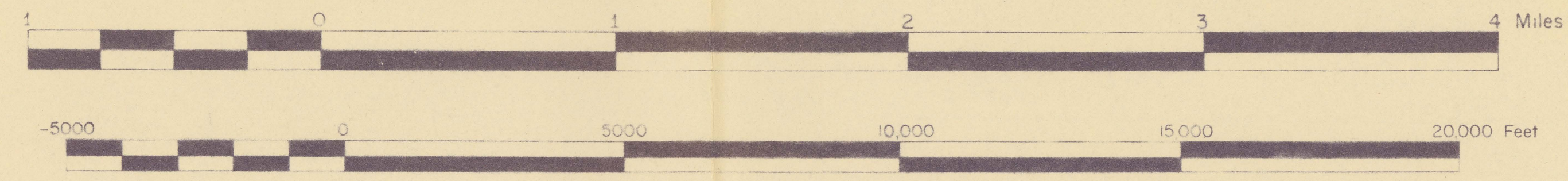
- Approximate axis of anticline
- Dip and strike of beds
- Dip and strike of beds (Strike approximate or uncertain)
- Fault showing apparent relative movement
- Bedding traces (Rubble line, outcrop, or scarp formed by sandstone bed. Dashed where exposure is poor or absent)
- Stadia station
- Triangulation station

Note: Rocks in this area are limited to the Torok Formation and Zones B, C, and D of the Nainashuk group, all of Lower Cretaceous age.
