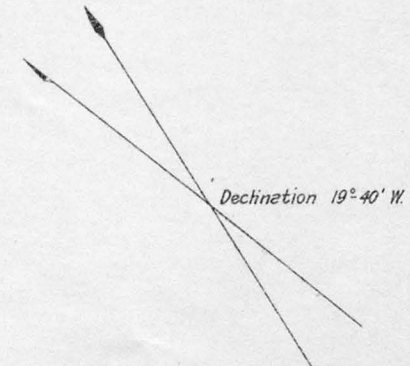
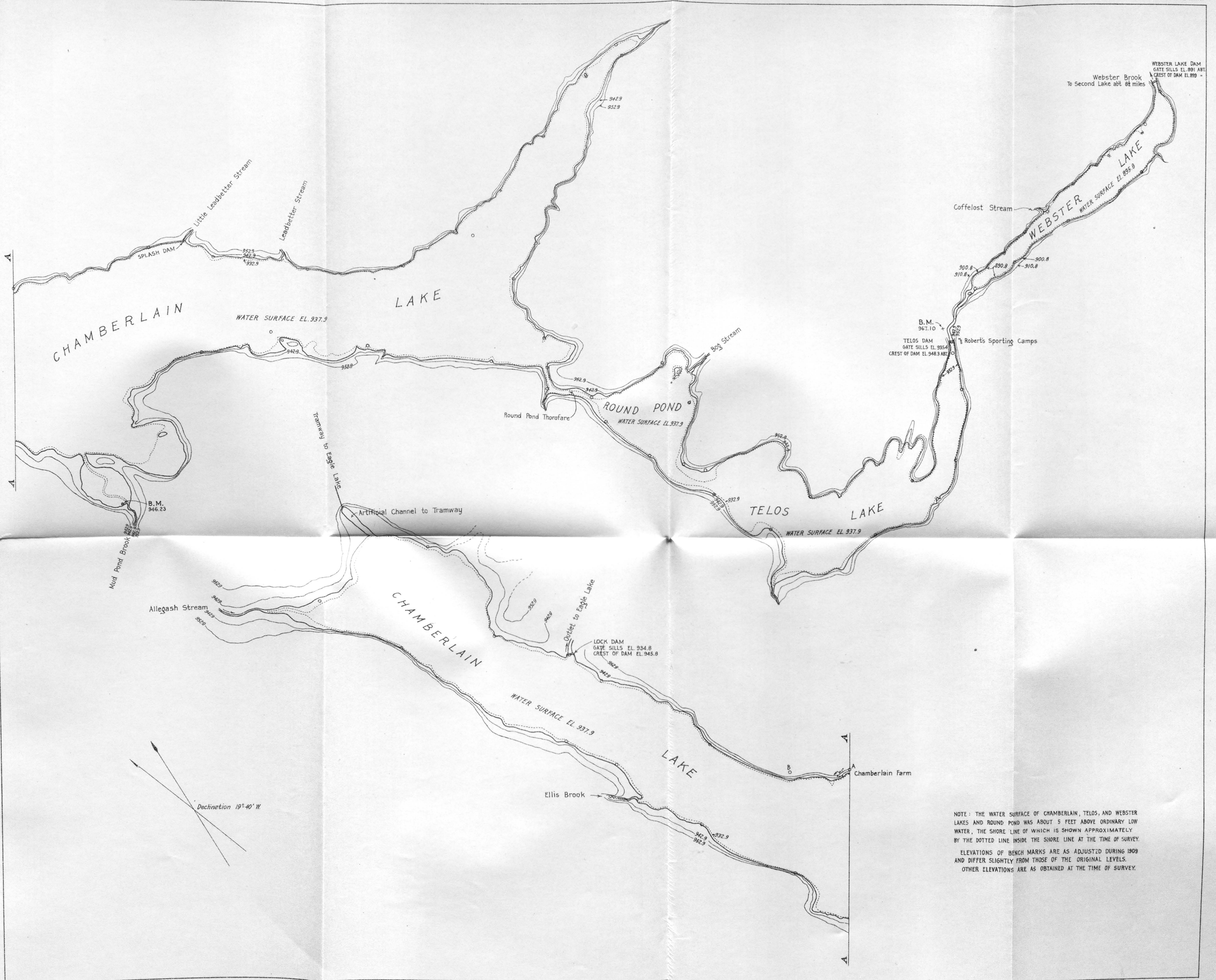


PLAN
PENOBSCOT RIVER DRAINAGE BASIN, MAINE
CHAMBERLAIN, TELOS, AND WEBSTER LAKES AND ROUND POND



NOTE: THE WATER SURFACE OF CHAMBERLAIN, TELOS, AND WEBSTER LAKES AND ROUND POND WAS ABOUT 5 FEET ABOVE ORDINARY LOW WATER, THE SHORE LINE OF WHICH IS SHOWN APPROXIMATELY BY THE DOTTED LINE INSIDE THE SHORE LINE AT THE TIME OF SURVEY. ELEVATIONS OF BENCH MARKS ARE AS ADJUSTED DURING 1909 AND DIFFER SLIGHTLY FROM THOSE OF THE ORIGINAL LEVELS. OTHER ELEVATIONS ARE AS OBTAINED AT THE TIME OF SURVEY.
