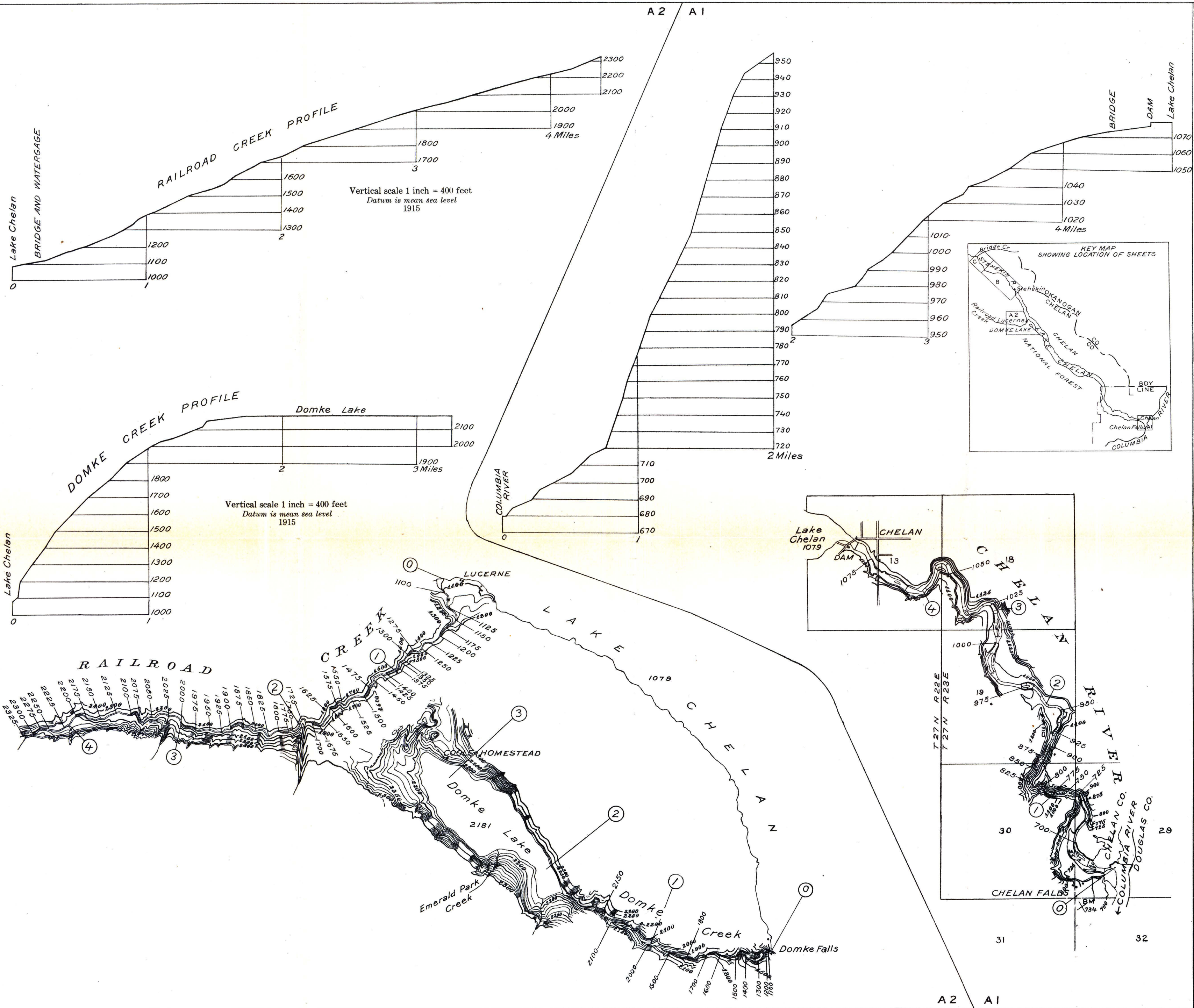


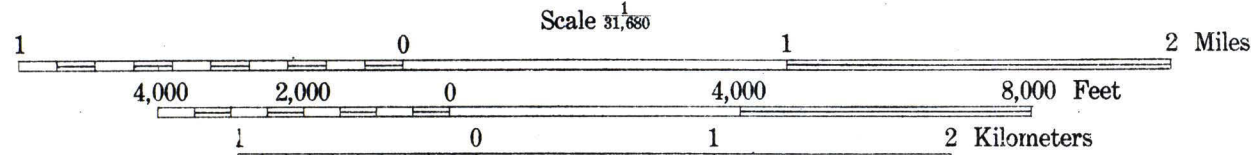
PLAN AND PROFILE OF

 AND CHELAN RIVER, LAKE TO MOUTH, WASHINGTON



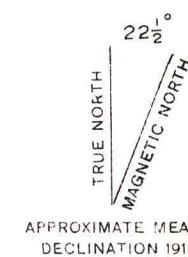
