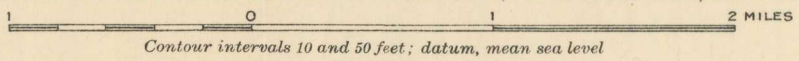




GEOLOGIC MAP OF MOKUAWEOEWO CALDERA, ON MAUNA LOA, HAWAII
