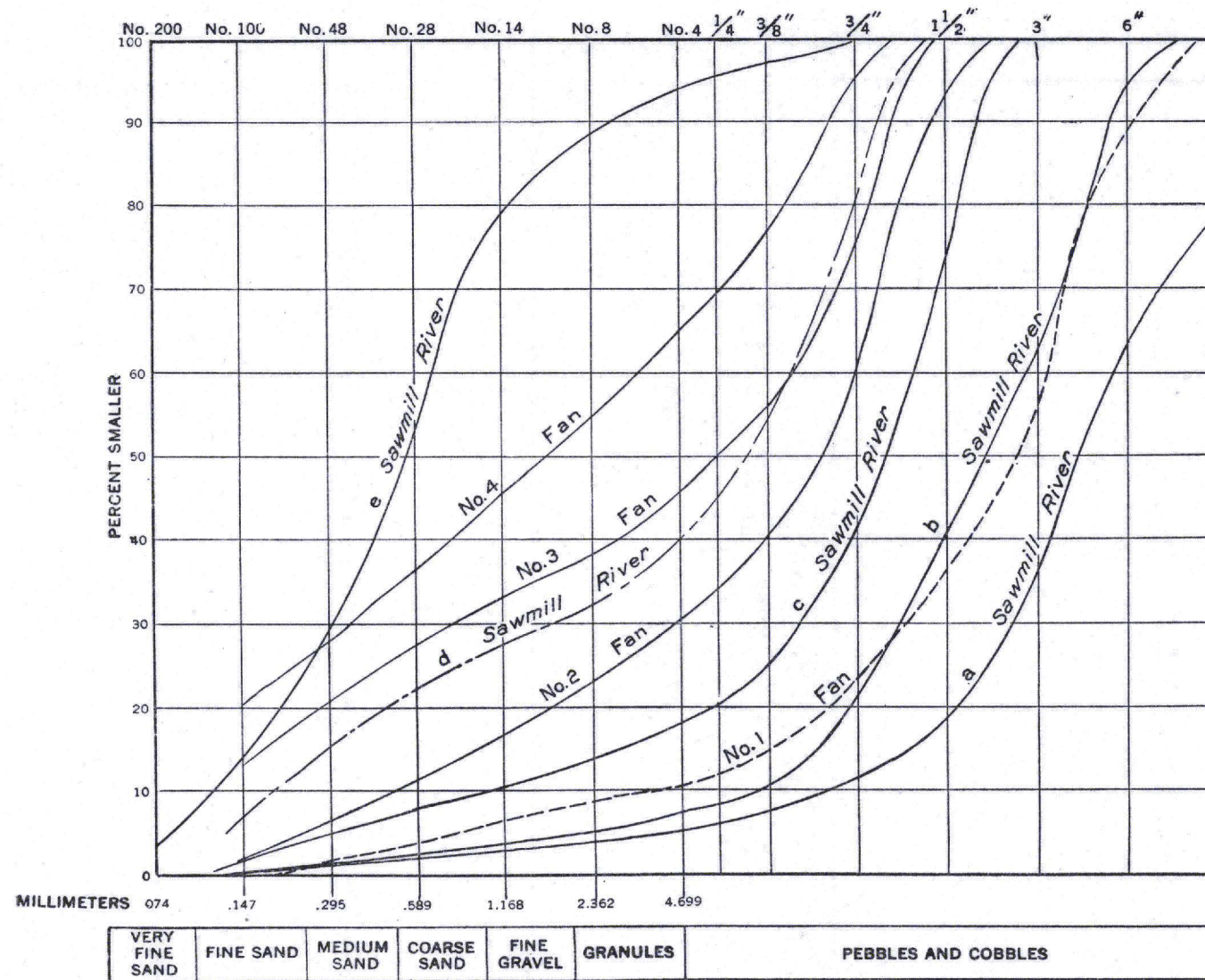
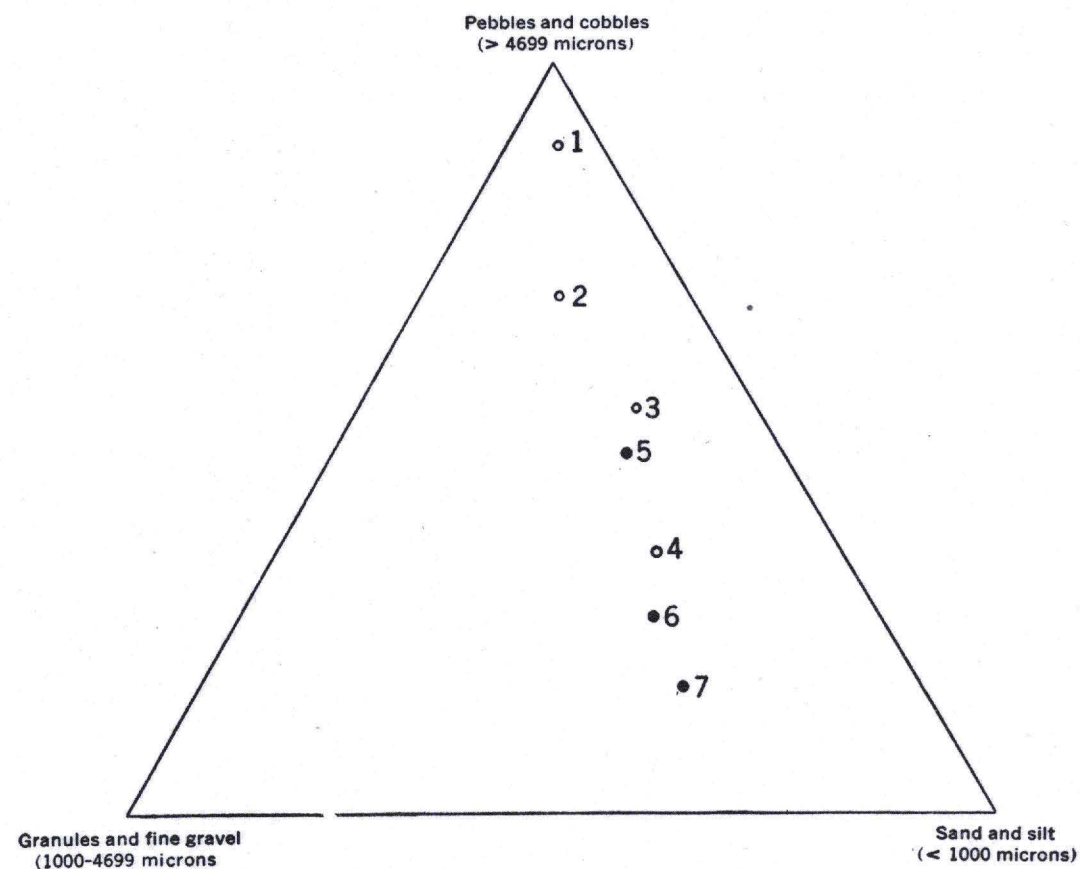


A. Sieve analyses for Connecticut, Westfield, Millers, and Deerfield Rivers

BED-LOAD CHARACTERISTICS OF CERTAIN CONNECTICUT VALLEY STREAMS.



○ Samples from alluvial fan, base of north side of Taylor Hill, 1 mi. WNW. of Montague (Greenfield quad.)

Detailed locations

- 1. Apex of fan
- 2. 200 ft. down slope from apex
- 3. 300 ft. down slope from apex
- 4. 430 ft. down slope from apex (near base of fan)
- Samples from alluvial cone of Pickens Creek, southern California
- 5. Lower end of canyon section
- 6, 7. North of Foothill Boulevard (about two-fifths of distance from apex to base of cone)
