Alluvium
Locally contains or overlies Tertiary age rocks of volcanic, lacustrine, or alluvial origin
- QTV
Volcanic rocks
(Not otherwise subdivided)
- Pu
Undifferentiated rocks
Locally may include older or younger rocks of various types
- Contact
- Fault
- Existing well
- Possible or typical well site
- Dry or unused well
- Spring
- Reservoir
- Tank
- Pipeline
