



EXPLANATION

- Irrigation well
- Domestic or stock well
- Well not in use
- Well abandoned or destroyed (as of 1961)
- Upper number (as) is altitude of water table; lower number (ds) is depth to water. Symbols >, greater than, and <, less than, used where exact measurements are not available. R indicates reported water level.
- Water-table contour
Contour interval 10 feet; contour interval in area south of Waterman Wash is 25 feet. Datum is mean sea level.
