

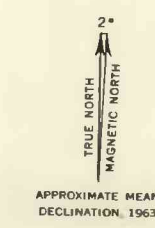
EXPLANATION

- Prairie du Chien Group
Yields small amounts of water from joints, solution channels, and sandy zones. Not important as aquifer in county.
- Sandstone
Yields small to moderate amounts of water to wells, depending on depth of well, thickness of formation, and character of matrix. Second-most important source of water in county.
- Crystalline rocks
Relatively impermeable; yield water locally from weathered or fractured zones.
