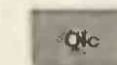
Artificial fill
Mapped only where fill is thick or extensive



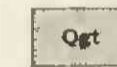
Talus
Coarse rock fragments accumulated at foot of cliffs



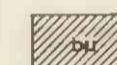
Outwash gravel
Gravel, sand, and discontinuous sheets of glacial till. Locally is very thin. Contact between outwash gravel and glacial till is nearly everywhere indefinite



Lacustrine clay
Clay, light-blue to gray; maximum observed thickness about 25 feet



Glacial till
Gravel and boulders, mostly compact, unsorted and clayey



Bedrock undifferentiated

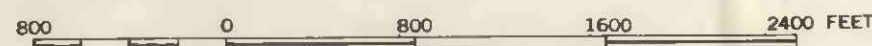
