


EXPLANATION

GLACIAL DEPOSITS



Outwash and lacustrine deposits
Medium to coarse sand and gravel interbedded with fine sand, silt, and clay; unconsolidated; generally well sorted and stratified



Till
Boulder to pebble gravel, sand, silt, and clay; unconsolidated; poorly sorted and unstratified



Mixed till and outwash
Till and outwash that grade into one another or are mixed in varying proportions

BEDROCK



Igneous and metamorphic rocks form the bedrock beneath the glacial deposits
